**Magnum 7500 Furnace Fuels**

**Product models covered:** Magnum 7500 Furnace

**Topic:** This technical bulletin will be addressing the different fuels that can be used in the Magnum 7500 Furnace.

**Information:** The Magnum 7500 Furnace is designed to burn a variety of fuels but will burn best with shelled corn, wheat or wood pellets.

There are a variety of fuels in their natural size that will burn just great such as edible beans, shelled field corn, shelled sweet corn, wheat, barley, oats when mixed with corn, wood pellets, cherry pits, olive pits, waste paper pellets and various grasses that have been processed into pellets.

Pea sized coal has been sold around the country for many years. You can mix in about 15% of the pea sized coal with corn or wood pellets and get a fairly decent burn. Burning coal has a lot more challenges because of its characteristics of clinkering and destroying fuel stirrers. We would suggest using small amounts only.

The best value is still shelled corn and you will get the best results using this fuel. Mixing in a little oats, wheat, and especially edible beans really cleans up the corn and enhances the combustion process.
